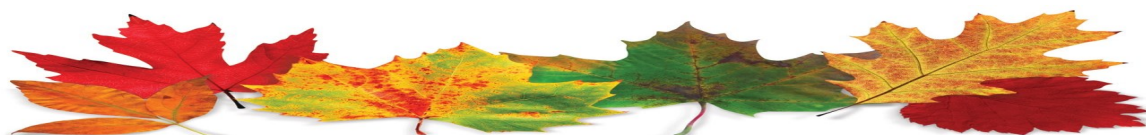

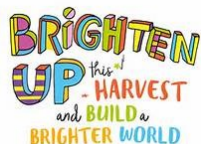
Flu Vaccination
