Primary and Secondary Admissions - September 2022

If your child is four years old between 1st September 2021 and 31st August 2022 or is currently in Year 6, now is the time to ensure that your child has a place in school for September 2022. For Lancashire resident families who require a Primary or Secondary school place in September 2022, the means of application is via Lancashire's on-line system at www.lancashire.gov.uk (then search for school admissions). This system is "live" and "quick and easy to use" and offers an e-mail receipt of all submitted applications. Please ensure that you hit the submit button when you are ready to send in your completed on-line application, You must apply even if you already have siblings at your preferred school. If you live in Lancashire, you can include "out of area" preferences on your on-line application. The closing dates for applications for September 2021 are at 11.59pm on: Secondary—31st October 2021 Primary—15th January 2022 Any difficulty with the on-line system—please contact LCC Customer Access Service on 0300 123 6707
