become a reality for the people of Ukraine and for all the world. Amen.

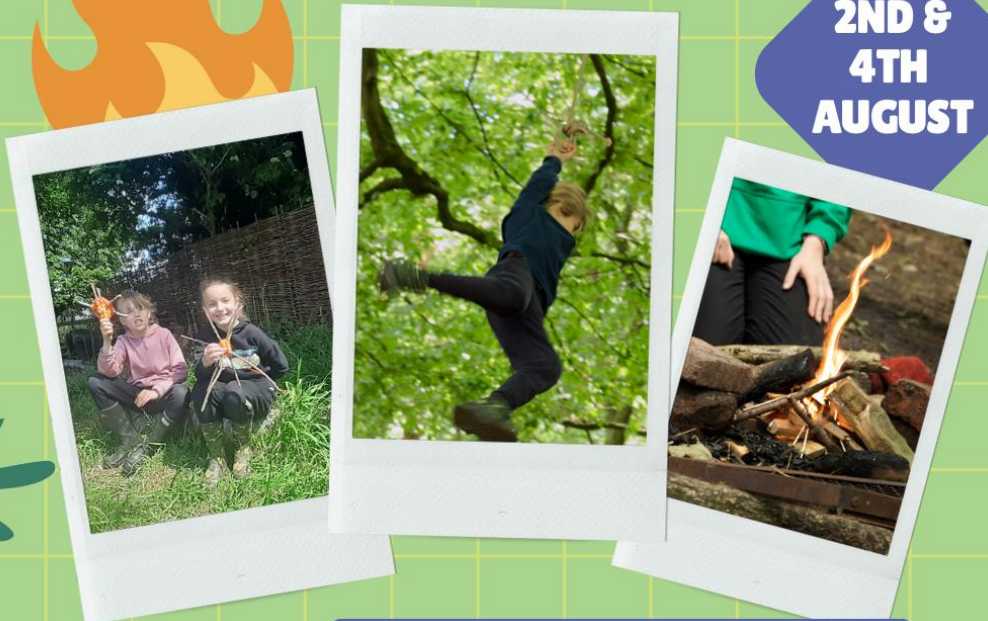
