Clarification on the 48-hour rule: there have been a number of queries recently about when children can come into school after vomiting or diarrhoea. Children must be absent from school for a full 48 hours after the final instance of vomiting or diarrhoea. These bugs do spread very quickly in schools. Please do not send your children in before the 48 hours is up and please do not ask us to make an exception. We are obliged to operate to the standard rules set for schools and we must apply the rule fairly and consistently. Thank you for your understanding.

Late arrivals: please note that children need to be in school ready to begin the school day at 8.55am. A number of children are still arriving after this time, sometimes several minutes after this time, resulting in a late mark in the register.

**Term time holiday:** just a reminder that we cannot authorise holidays in term time unless the circumstances are deemed to be exceptional. LCC will issue penalty notices where unauthorised absences reach the necessary threshold: 5 days in one term or 7 days over two consecutive terms.

## For September

Enrichment Clubs in September: from September, Mr Warren will be conducting band practice as part of the school day and so there will be no band practice after school. On Wednesdays, there will be Forest School for years 1 to 6. An email and text will be sent out with more details at 10am on Monday. Enrichment clubs will be reviewed again in the spring.
