Open Evening: on Tuesday 7 November we will be holding an open evening in school between 4pm and 6pm. This is so that parents of children due to start Reception in September 2024 can look round school and meet our teachers.

Nasal flu vaccines: will be given in school to all children whose parents wish them to have it. Please see the information below for details of how to consent or opt out.

This vaccination is recommended to help protect your child against flu. Flu can be an unpleasant illness and can cause serious complications. Vaccinating your child will also help protect more vulnerable family and friends by preventing the spread of Flu. There may be a rebound in Flu levels this coming winter following low levels in the past 2 years. The vaccination is free and is a quick, simple, painless spray up the nose.

- If in the few days prior to vaccination your child has been wheezy.
- If after consenting you take your child to your GP surgery to receive their vaccination

Lunches: if your child normally brings a packed lunch on a particular day but, for whatever reason, needs a school lunch that day instead, we can accommodate this as long as food is ordered with the kitchen by 9.30am. So if you unexpectedly need your child to have a lunch, please let the office know first thing (either by email or phone) so that we can ensure your child makes a lunch choice before the deadline. Children do not always remember to tell us, even when prompted, and this can lead to difficulties at lunch time.

The 48-hour Rule: your periodic reminder about this rule. Unfortunately, we cannot accept children into school until 48 hours has passed from the last time they were sick or experienced diarrhoea. As you know, this is the official health rule and we are obliged to implement it consistently. Thank you for your support in this matter.

Children in Need: on Friday 17 November we will be marking Children in Need by wearing anything yellow, or spotty in school. A link for donations will be sent out nearer the time so that families do not need to send money into school.

School gate: when entering or leaving school premises, please ensure you close the gate. This is for the safety and security of your children.

Harvest collection: we are still collecting! If you are able to send in any donations of non-perishable food items in the next week, we will make sure they reach those who need them. Many thanks for your support.

Smart-style watches in school: if your child needs to wear a watch in school, please ensure it is a plain analogue watch. Digital/smart/smart-style watches, many of which make noises and have colourful displays, are proving to be a distraction in class. In addition, they would have to be removed for PE and then there is a risk of them getting lost.

PE Days: please note that PE kits will be kept in school in order to allow for flexibility in the timetable so that we can consider other events going on in school, the weather, and so on. Please send PE kits in a bag on a Monday morning. Children will bring them home for washing on a Friday. Please ensure each item is labelled clearly.

Earrings in school: a polite reminder that small plain studs are the only earrings that are allowed in school. Please ensure they are NOT worn on PE days.
