Reception children: have been sent home with the reception health questionnaire in their bags today. Please would parents complete, seal, and return to school. The school nurse will collect the questionnaires in a few days. This allows any concerns to be looked at swiftly.

Nasal flu vaccines: will be given in school to all children whose parents wish them to have it. Please see the information below for details of how to consent or opt out.

This vaccination is recommended to help protect your child against flu. Flu can be an unpleasant illness and can cause serious complications. Vaccinating your child will also help protect more vulnerable family and friends by preventing the spread of Flu. There may be a rebound in Flu levels this coming winter following low levels in the past 2 years. The vaccination is free and is a quick, simple, painless spray up the nose.
